OUR VENUE

Built in 1936, HMS Belfast is an iconic London landmark, moored on the River Thames. From the D-Day landings and Arctic Convoys of the Second World War, to the Korean War and the peacekeeping commissions of the 1960s, no other vessel surviving in Britain today has seen historic events of the same magnitude.

The ship offers iconic panoramic views of the Tower of London, the Gherkin, and Tower Bridge. Event guests can freely explore the expansive decks, taking in the captivating stories and rich history at their leisure.

Through our 'Coffee for Causes' programme for every kilo of coffee sold we donate 30p to local charities and community projects




Legacy

- ▶ Southwark Tube Station - 11 minute walk


